Day 1: 11th October 2021

On the first day, the participants were welcomed by the Romanian team in the conference room of Traian Hotel.. The Principal of “Alexandru Ioan Cuza” Secondary School, Magdalena Cotlerenco-Medeleanu and the project coordinator from Romania, Daniela Petre, delivered the opening speech. Then, the coordinators from each partner county (Turkey, Greece, Spain, Italy and Romania), introduced the participating teams.

It followed a presentation of the program of Learning Teaching Training Activities scheduled during the mobility. We mention that the Italian team participated online to all the activities.

The guests were invited on a virtual tour of Braila City and Romania country in order to discover famous landmarks, local customs and traditions.

Each country had a presentation of the situation of the refugees and migrant students in their school and city.



In the second part of the meeting, there was a workshop where the participant teachers identified the obstacles that hinder the integration of students of other nationalities in the educational system of the partner countries. They had presentations and filled in a questionnaire on this topic.





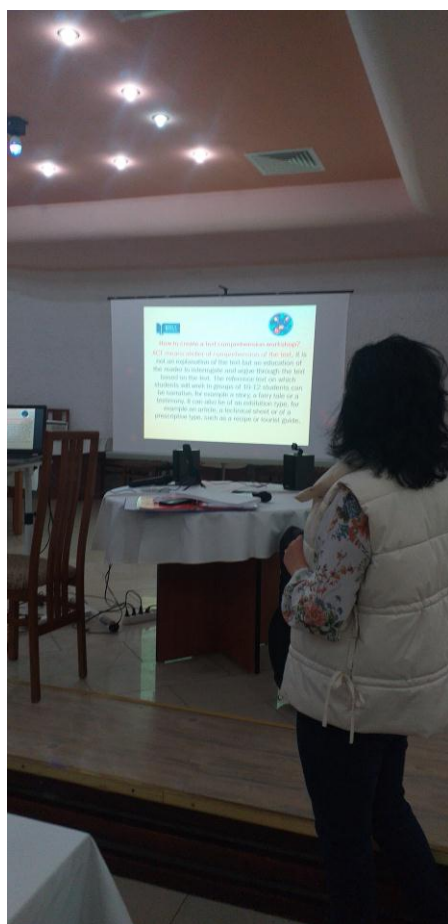
After lunch, the guests went on a guided tour of Braila city and they visited famous sights, historical buildings, churches, etc. The guide offered information about the history of Braila and famous people who were born or lived in this city.



The day finished with dinner in a restaurant where our guests had the chance to taste local food (such as fish and "papanashi").

Day 2: 12th October 2021

On the second day, the participants met in the conference room of Traian Hotel where they worked on the ROLL method. In the first part of the day, the coordinator from Romania, Daniela Petre, presented the theoretical notions of ROLL method, explained the stages of the process of teaching-learning, the role of this method in teaching learning to multicultural classes as it is an efficient solution to obtain competencies in text comprehension by students of other nationalities.



Next there was a presentation of the “Text comprehension laboratory” The theoretical course was followed by practical examples of texts, types of exercises that can be used for different levels, sites which offer detailed information on the ROLL method, a variety of free resources and materials, annual and lesson plans, tutorials, etc.



In the second part of the day, after lunch in the restaurant of the hotel, the teachers participated to workshops. The teachers from each delegation had the task to select or write a text in their own language and then make up exercises to assess the students' competencies according to the ROLL method. All the outcomes and the materials produced will be included in a brochure.



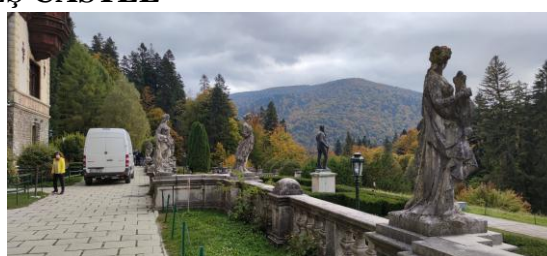
The last activity scheduled for this day was the coordinators' meeting where teachers discussed about the level of achievement of the objectives of the project.

Day 3: 13th October 2021

The third day was dedicated to cultural visits in Sinaia and Bușteni. Thus, our guests had the chance to see famous landmarks from Romania such as Bran Castle, also well-known as “Dracula’s Castle”, Peleș Castle and Caraiman Monastery from Bușteni. On the way, they went to a fair where they could see Romanian traditional folk clothes with their special embroidery, peasant vests made of sheep fur, painted pottery, handmade crafts, wooden toys, etc. Even if it was a long journey, the participants were very excited about the beauty of the landscapes and the grandeur of the castles.

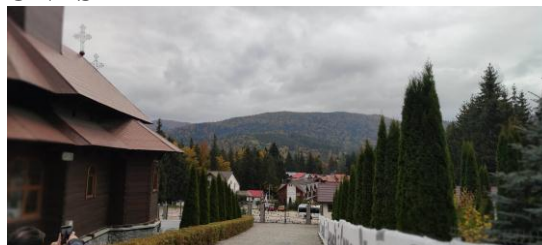

Day 4: 14th October 2021

On the fourth day, the teachers visited “Alexandru Ioan Cuza” School from Brăila where they were welcomed as the Romanian custom requires with “bread and salt”.

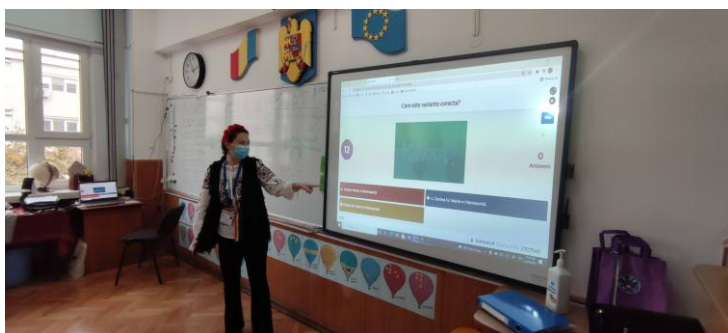


Then they participated to an activity where Daniela Petre demonstrated how the ROLL method can be used with students of other nationalities. The purpose of this lesson was to let our partners observe how our Syrian, Turkish and Italian students build and improve text comprehension competencies with the ROLL method.



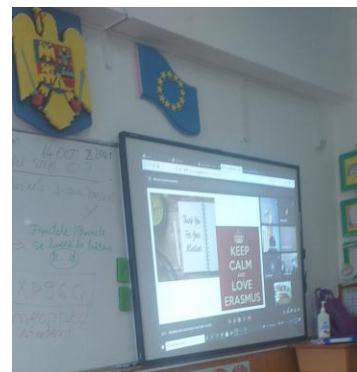


The next activity was performed by Simona Barbu. She used modern techniques such as web 2.0 tools (Nearpod, Wordwall, Kahoot) to show how we can teach and assess Romanian language to immigrant students in a fun and friendly way.



It followed a seminar with the topic *“Language Education of Immigrant Students”*. At the meeting were invited inspectors from Braila Inspectorate, teachers from other schools, the Principal of “AL. I. Cuza” School, our partners from this project and teachers from the hosting Romanian team. There were many presentations about the situation of immigrant students in Braila city, the solutions adopted for the integration of students of other nationalities, exchange of good practices, opportunities and threats when teaching multicultural classes. The articles will be included in the brochure of the project.

Our guests had the chance to ask questions and receive detailed information. Our partners have found out that in “AL. I. Cuza” School we organize Romanian language courses for all the immigrant students who live in Brăila city to help them learn the language and integrate in the Romanian educational system.. At the same time, they continue to preserve their native language, religion, traditions and celebrations.



The day continued with meals in a local restaurant and visit of the area.

Day 5: 15th October 2021

The fifth day started with the closing ceremony and awarding of the certificates of attendance for the mobility organized in Braila, Romania. The coordinators from each country delivered a speech about the project activities performed this week



Then the participating teachers carried out the evaluation of the learning-teaching-training activities. They filled in the feedback survey which measured their level of satisfaction concerning the quality of the activities and the hospitality of the Romanian hosting team.

The last activity was the coordinators' meeting, where the coordinators established the dates for the next mobilities, they discussed about the preparations for the mobility in Greece and the activities scheduled for the following months.





The farewell dinner offered another cultural evening where partners from each country presented their traditional dances and songs: Spanish, Greek, Turkish and Romanian. Our foreign friends tasted typical Romanian dishes. It was a lovely experience for all the participants!
